CD PROJEKT wraps up the third quarter of 2024

- The CD PROJEKT Group posted 228 million PLN in Q3 revenues owing to strong sales of Cyberpunk 2077, its Phantom Liberty expansion, as well as The Witcher 3
- Total post-release sales of Cyberpunk 2077 topped 30 million copies, while the Phantom Liberty expansion has sold over 8 million copies
- Project Polaris the first instalment in the new Witcher trilogy has progressed to full-scale production

– I'm proud to confirm that several weeks ago the Polaris team wrapped up preproduction and moved on to full-scale production – the most intensive phase of development. We are very pleased with our progress on this project, and I wish to thank the team for its dedication. – says Michał Nowakowski, Joint CEO of CD PROJEKT.

The Company also announced that both products from the Cyberpunk universe have reached important sales milestones.

– In less than four years since release we've already sold 30 million copies of Cyberpunk 2077, and as for Phantom Liberty – in just over a year it has sold over 8 million copies. These are impressive figures. I'm very happy to see a large, dedicated community coalesce around our Cyberpunk games. In the coming year the base game, along with its expansion, will be released to a new group of users: owners of Mac devices powered by Apple Silicon chips. – announces Michał Nowakowski.

In the third quarter of 2024 revenues of the CD PROJEKT Group amounted to 228 million PLN, with a consolidated net profit of 78 million PLN.

– We're looking back at another very strong quarter. Cyberpunk 2077 and its Phantom Liberty expansion continue to sell very well, but The Witcher 3 is also performing admirably. Our cumulative net profit for 2024 is already nearing a quarter billion PLN – even though we're only on the cusp of the most intensive quarter in terms of sales. – summarizes Piotr Nielubowicz, CFO of CD PROJEKT.
